The Summit will bring together community coalitions, colleges and universities to create a framework to implement an environmental management approach to change the social culture in the North Texas region.

Summit Objectives

- Increase community awareness of the problems associated with underage drinking, binge drinking and drinking and driving on college campuses and in the community.
- Learn evidence based strategies to decrease community tolerance of underage drinking.
- Learn evidence based strategies that decrease the availability of alcohol to students and create a safe and healthy campus and community environment.
- Develop an understanding of a comprehensive framework for community and campus-based prevention that combines environmental and individual approaches.
- Increase benefits of working together to understand the infrastructure, identify problems and develop solutions to reduce underage and binge alcohol use and negative consequences such as drinking and driving, school drop out rates, violence, etc.

Who Should Attend?

We encourage all campuses and coalitions to send a team of three (3) to five (5) representatives. Appropriate team representatives include a campus Alcohol and Drug Coordinator; enforcement officers; administration, judicial, student activities, housing, and counseling facility; Health Director; peer advisors/peer educators and members of community-based organizations. Individuals concerned with underage and high risk drinking are encouraged to attend.
